You are invited to join the parishes of Corpus Christi & Marino in celebrating the Feast of the Divine Mercy in Corpus Christi Church, Home Farm Road, Dublin 9 Holy Hour 3.00pm Mass at 4.00pm.

Divine Mercy is a Roman Catholic solemnity celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. It is originally based on the Catholic devotion to the Divine Mercy that Saint Faustina Kolwaska reported as part of her encounter with Jesus, it is associated with special promises issued by the Church. The feast of Divine Mercy, as recorded in her diary, receives from Jesus himself, the biggest promises of Grace related to the Devotion of Divine Mercy. Jesus states that the soul that goes to Sacramental Confession and receives Holy communion on that day, shall obtain the total forgiveness of all sins.
