The annual collection for ACCORD Dublin, the Diocesan Agency for Marriage and the Family, will be at all Masses this weekend. The collection for ACCORD will replace the usual Share Collection. ACCORD Dublin offers Marriage Preparation Courses, counselling for couples and individuals experiencing difficulties in their relationships and a Relationship and Sexuality Programmes for primary and secondary Schools. ACCORD Dublin needs your support.

The Diocese has just launched an online survey, as part of the work of the Sacraments Review Group set up by the Archbishop. The brief of the Review Group is to consult widely and deeply and to make recommendations on we prepare for and celebrate the Sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation in the future.
