Easter Monday (& Easter Week)

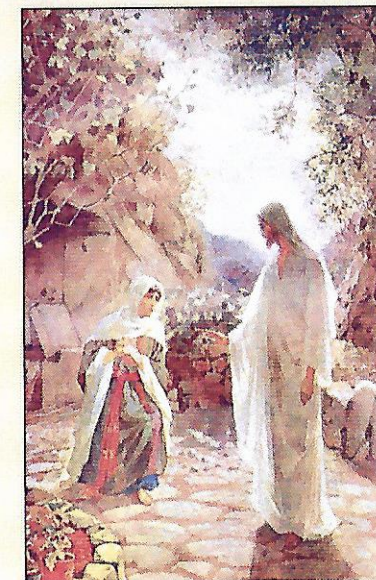

Divine Mercy Sunday (Sunday 28th April)

The Divine Mercy Devotion similar to devotion to the Sacred Heart, had its origin in the now approved revelations made to St. Faustina Kowalska (1905-1938). The devotion has the blessing of the Church and was especially promulgated by Pope John Paul II who declared Sister Faustina a saint on 30th April 2000. The Divine Mercy image is the image of the Risen Christ on the first Easter, on the evening of the Resurrection, miraculously appearing in the upper room and bestowing on the Apostles the power of the Holy Spirit to forgive sins. His hand is raised in blessing, he shows them His wounds, and Jesus is looking for their trust.
