### Adult Faith Classes.

Our Diocese has organised a choice of two courses for Adults to deepen their Catholic Faith. Both begin in the Autumn.

- Pathways – a two-year, part time, non-academic programme designed to help adults explore reflect on and learn more about their faith. Pathways takes place in Clonliffe College on Thursday evenings from 7.00 to 9.30pm and runs from late September to late May over two years. The cost of this course is €400.
- Faith for Life is designed to help participants to discover more energising and empowering ways to live out their faith in the reality of todays world: through relationships, family, home, workplaces, and the events of daily life. The course aims to help participants to be more active, open and willing to work for change. The course is over four weekends at Clonliffe college and the cost is €400.
