Child Protection Information Evening Tuesday 24th 7.30pm

Dublin diocese requires that, every three years, all volunteers in parish ministry, not only are garda vetted before they begin/renew their ministry but are also requested to attend an information session on their responsibilities to the parish community. This is the minimum requirement. (For those working directly with children there is a separate, more intense, training session). Ballygall will host the first on Tuesday 24th September at 7.30pm. Corpus Christi will also host a similar information on Thursday 26th September also at 7.30pm. This is to enable all volunteers in the grouping to attend.

Crosscare

The Crosscare Annual Collection for Community, Homeless and Youth services takes place this weekend Sat 31st August and Sun 1st September and will replace the Share collection. Last year Crosscare accommodated almost 1,000 people in their homeless services and helped 78 families and over 100 individuals move into their own homes. Through their food banks and meal services, over 175,000 meals were distributed to those in need and 14,000 parcels of food were delivered to families. Over 4,000 young people were supported through Crosscare's Youth Work service through voluntary youth clubs and summer projects and 400 teenagers and their families found the help and support they needed in Teen Counselling Donors can also contribute on line at www.crosscare.ie
