Diocesan Safeguarding Day – Sunday 22 September / Child Protection Information Evening Tuesday 24th 7.30pm

Our Child Protection Officers will be speaking at all masses this weekend. Dublin Diocese requires that, every three years, all volunteers in parish ministry, not only are garda vetted before they begin/renew their ministry but are also requested to attend an information session on their responsibilities to the parish community. This is the minimum requirement. (For those working directly with children there is a separate, more intense, training session). *Ballygall will host the first on **Tuesday 24th September** at 7.30pm.* Corpus Christi will also host a similar information on Thursday 26th September also at 7.30pm. This is to enable all volunteers in the grouping to attend.
