November – A time to remember our Dead

There is a great tradition of visiting our churches or cemeteries during the month of the Holy Souls. A reminder that during the First week indulgences may be gained for the Faithful Departed.

On the 1st (All Saint's Day) & 2nd (All Soul's Day) By visiting a church and there reciting one *Our Father* and the *Apostle's Creed*, One Plenary Indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls, may be gained, by all those who:

- Have **confessed** (at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November)
- **Received Holy Communion** (any day from 1-8 Nov)
- **Prayed for the Pope's intentions** (one *Our Father*, and *Hail Mary* or any other prayer of one's choice)

Also, between 1st & 8th Nov the Faithful who **visit a cemetery** and pray for the dead may gain One Plenary Indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls.

November – Month of The Holy Souls

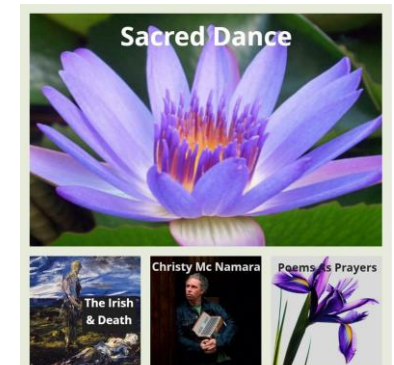
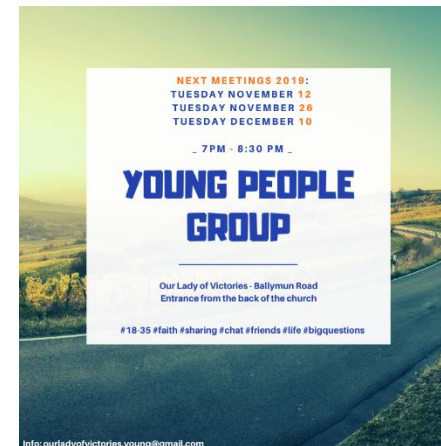
