Church to open for Mass from Monday June 29th.

We intend to have our church re-opened for the celebration of mass as outlined in recent Government briefings. We will have to observe new guidelines to conform with strict adherence to the norms of public health. We have a long way to go before we are back to normal and our capacity will be limited and everyone must play their part. To keep the social distance requirements of 2 metres we can facilitate 100 people present in the church. To ensure this happens smoothly we will be needing your support in different ways. **We will require:** -

- extra stewards to ensure correct numbers are admitted.
- Stewards to help people to their seats and for Holy Communion safety.
- Volunteers will be needed to wipe down seats after each Mass.
- We are being encouraged to have a one-way system in operation. This will need your support to ensure it works.
