### Volunteers for helping with Mass

### Baptisms

Baptisms take place on Saturdays only. People will be advised of times available. The monthly meetings will be postponed for the moment.

**Funerals** are still private celebrations with a cap of 50 attendees composed of family members & relatives only. Funeral Masses are celebrated at 11am until restrictions are lifted. Neighbours and friends can view online or remain outside the front of the church keeping Social Distancing, refraining from embracing, etc. There they can participate by listening through the speakers. Holy communion will also be brought out to those who wish to receive.

### Church Opening

For the moment the obligation to attend Sunday Mass still does not apply. The church is open for private prayer from 12.00 to 6.00pm (approx.) daily. We try to reopen by 11am until after 8pm. On Saturday evenings the church will close at 5.30pm to facilitate preparation for Mass. Please adhere to the HSE guidelines & restrictions and advice in porch. Face coverings are becoming the norm especially when we cannot keep 2 metres apart in shops and on public transport. (In church we are strongly recommended to wear masks).

### Weekly Donations to Parish & Diocese.

Thank you to those who are continuing to support the parish, the priests & the diocese in different ways, through the Family Offering envelopes and online. For those who attending weekday mass instead of Sunday we have bags left out for the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> collections at the doors on the way out from Mass.
