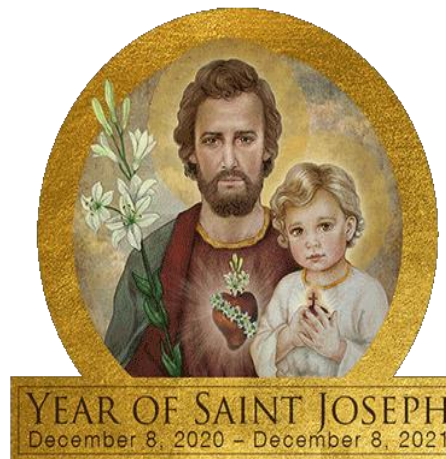
Living in Unsettling Times – Reflections for the Time & Season

2021 – Year of St Joseph

St. Joseph, Husband of Mary – Feast Day 19th March.

Pope Francis has proclaimed a special “Year of St Joseph, to mark the 150th anniversary of Blessed Pope Pius IX’s declaration of St Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. This began on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception 2020 and extending to the same feast in 2021.

His Apostolic Letter 'Patris corde' (“With a Father’s Heart”) is written against the backdrop of the Covid-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of “ordinary” people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day. In this, they resemble Saint Joseph, “the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence,” who nonetheless played “an incomparable role in the history of salvation.”

At the conclusion of his Letter, he includes a prayer to St Joseph, which he encourages all of us to pray together. (see above)
