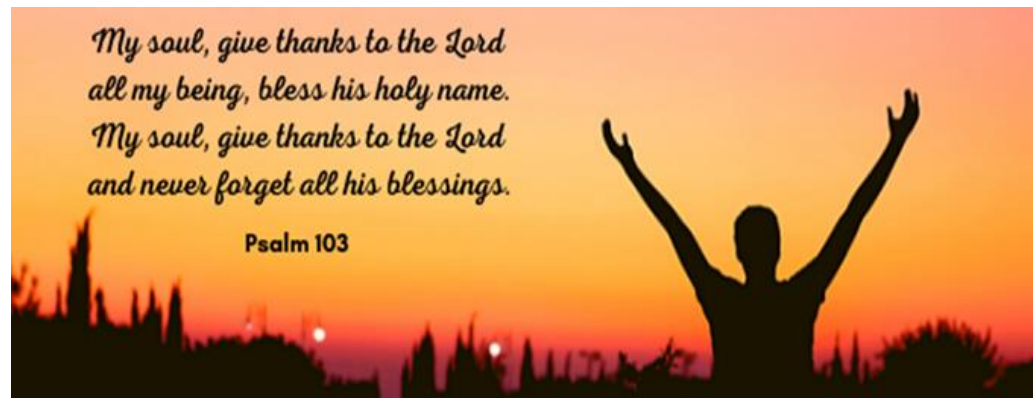
Peters Pence
