## Diocesan Clerical Changes

Fr Richard Sheehy, Moderator of our Grouping of Parishes, based in Glasnevin is being moved to Brackenstown, Swords. Fr Kieran Dunne will be coming to Glasnevin as curate. Fr. Joseph Ryan (Ballygall) has been appointed as moderator of the grouping of parishes, based here in Ballygall. All moves take place in mid-July.

## Summer Dues Collection & Return to Mass

The Archbishop has written to us thanking each parish for their support towards the clergy through the Summer Dues Collection introduced last year, enabling a 5% increase in the monthly stipend to priests last August. With the return of more parishioners to church over the past few months the regular First Collection has enabled a further 5% increase. There is, however, still a 30% drop in the First Collection in the first four months of 2022 compared with the same period in 2019. He proposes that we relaunch the Summer Dues Collection from 17<sup>th</sup> June. This can be returned over the summer months. The Archbishop reminds us of the value of coming together as a community to celebrate the Lord's Day. The webcam etc were most helpful during the pandemic but it is time to restore Sunday Mass as the source and summit of our Christian commitment both through communion with the Lord and each other. We are called to listen carefully to the Spirit calling us to build a future full of hope.

## Pathways: Exploring Faith & Ministry

Application is now open for the next intake of participants for Pathways. The programme, run by the Dublin Archdiocese, begins in September, in DCU St Patrick's Campus. Pathways is a two-year, one evening a week course, for adults of all ages who wish to explore their faith. It runs from late September to May each year. No exams and no written work. The only requirement is an openness to listening to others and to participate.
