World Youth Day – Lisbon 2023

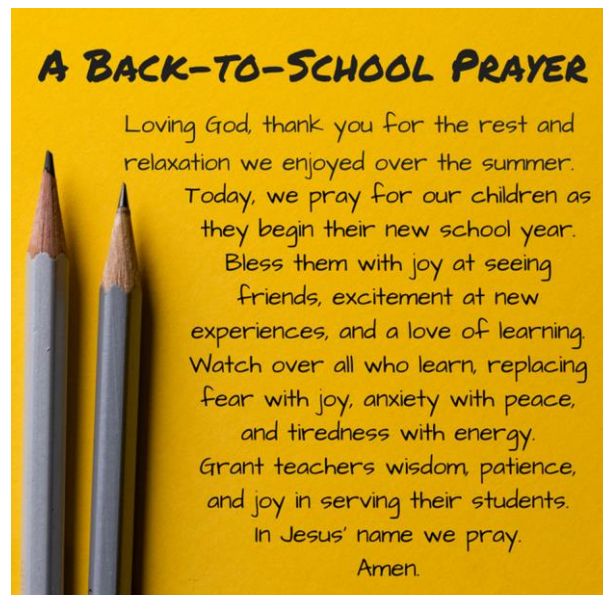
