#### Peace in Our Hearts

As we go through life, we sometimes make enemies (even Jesus did that). In fact, there is a humorous saying that goes; "Friends come and go, but enemies accumulate." So the older we are, the more enemies we might have, particularly if we are inclined to bear grudges. This can cause us stress, but Jesus tells us that if we find it in our hearts to forgive, then his peace will come to dwell in our hearts.

#### Not Our Fault

Unforgiveness is destructive, and robs us of our interior peace. In many ways, it is like a wound inflicted upon us, one which we, by choice, don't allow to heal so that we can show everyone what has happened to us, and tell them who is responsible.

This may give us a certain perverse satisfaction, but in the final analysis we are still wounded and suffer pain, even if it is not our fault.

#### **Finding Life**

Unforgiveness is similar. We may feel justified in holding onto unforgiveness but, ultimately, it will deprive us of a joyful and peaceful life. St Paul advises his disciples that we should ...
