Twin Pillars – St Mary's & St. Andrew's

In his homily for the Feast of St Kevin at St Mary's Pro-Cathedral on Monday, Archbishop Farrell said:

- The Church is called to work actively towards restoring a living heart to our cities.
- The centre of a city – its heart – needs people, and people need worthy spaces to live and to be – to be with each other, and to be with 'the Other' – Our God who constantly creates us and recreates us.
- A living Church is a community that looks towards the other and goes out towards the other, not only to new generations in new places, but also in new ways in old places.
- In that spirit, I am asking the Holy Father to designate St Mary's as the Cathedral for Dublin as part of a renewed pastoral and missionary strategy at the centre of our Diocese.
- This will involve having St Mary's and St Andrew's (Westland Row) as twin pillars for the worthy celebration of Catholic life in Dublin in its liturgical, pastoral and cultural dimensions.
