St Vincent De Paul collection

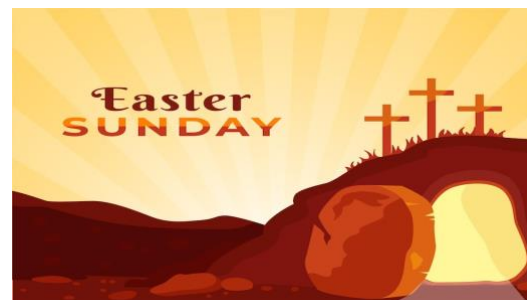
The monthly collection for St Vincent De Paul takes place at all masses next weekend.
